



What Causes Autism?




1.9% of children in the U.S. are diagnosed with ASD

Most common factor of the environment



Society



- Life is extreme fast unpredictable
- Too many sensory stimuli
- No small local communities

(Single parent with an autistic child)

- Communication is an industry
- Big school groups (30+ children in a class
- Open office places

How to shape future services



- Use the knowledge we need professionals
- Structure Predictability
 - Time (schedule)
 - Space (architecture)
- Focus on individual needs
 - Modify the curriculum
 - Modify the communication (AAC tools)
 - Create meaningful tasks
- Decrease sensory stimuli
 - Smaller classes
 - Less screens
- Be patient!
